
THREE RIVERS MERIT BADGE DAY

IMPORTANT CLASS INFO

SEE CLASS SCHEDULES AND SIZES IN CHART BELOW

ART: Read the merit badge book.

AUTOMOTIVE MAINTENANCE: Read the merit badge book.

BIRD STUDY: Read the merit badge book.

CITIZENSHIP IN THE COMMUNITY: Read the merit badge book. Requirements 2a, 5, 7a and 7b should be done before class and ready to discuss. Requirements 3, 4b, and 7c will not be done in class, but counselor will sign as completed if you bring your work to class with you. Requirement 8 can be presented to the class if completed.

CITIZENSHIP IN THE NATION: Read the merit badge book.

CITIZENSHIP IN THE WORLD: Read the merit badge book.

COMMUNICATIONS: Read the merit badge book. Requirements 3 and 4 must be completed before class. Requirements 5, 7, and 8 will not be completed in class, but the counselor will sign off as completed if you bring your work to class with you.

CRIME PREVENTION/FINGERPRINTING: Read the merit badge book.

ELECTRICITY: Read the merit badge book. Requirements 2 and 8 will not be completed in class.

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS: Read the merit badge book and bring to class with you along with printed worksheet. **MUST HAVE PREVIOUSLY EARNED THE FIRST AID MERIT BADGE IN ORDER TO TAKE THIS CLASS!** Complete requirements 2c, 8b, and 9a before class and bring to class with you.

ENERGY: Read the merit badge book. Complete requirements 1a and 4 before class.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE: Read the merit badge book. Requirements 3 and 4 will not be covered in class.

FIRST AID: Read the merit badge book. Complete requirement 5 and bring to class with you.

GENEALOGY: Read the merit badge book. Requirements 2, 3, 4b, 6, and 7 must be completed before class. IF THESE REQUIREMENTS ARE NOT COMPLETED BEFOREHAND, THEN THE SCOUT CAN NOT ATTEND THIS CLASS!

HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONS: Read the merit badge book. Requirement 8 must be done before class.

HOME REPAIR: Read the merit badge book. Requirement 3 should be completed before class.

LEATHERWORK: Read the merit badge book. Must be able to swing a hammer with force. Must bring an article of leather that needs cleaning.

LIFE TO EAGLE: *Not a merit badge class!* Scouts should be a Life Scout to attend. Our district Eagle Chair will instruct on the correct processes and paperwork while completing your project and journey to Eagle.

MOVIEMAKING: Read the merit badge book. Scouts will need to bring a phone or other device with video recording capabilities in order to complete requirements.

NATURE: Read the merit badge book. Some requirements may not be covered in class.

PERSONAL MANAGEMENT: Read the merit badge book. **SCOUTS SHOULD BE AT LEAST 13 AND 1**ST **CLASS!** Requirements 1a, 1b2, 1b3, 8a, 8b, and 8c should be completed before class, and the scout should be ready to discuss. Requirement 2 will not be completed in class.

RAILROADING: Read the merit badge book.

TRAFFIC SAFETY/FINGERPRINTING: Read the merit badge book.

WOODWORKING: Read the merit badge book.
