IMPORTANT CLASS INFO

We ask that all scouts read the merit badge pamphlet in advance to prepare.

Prerequisites and items not covered during class are listed below

if applicable. Please ask your scouts to Be Prepared!

CHEMISTRY:

CITIZENSHIP IN THE NATION: Requirements #5 and #8. Please bring merit badge book, printed worksheet, and a way to take notes. Bring phone or tablet for internet research.

COMMUNICATIONS: Prepare the five-minute speech for requirement 3 and the interview with someone they know or admire for requirement 4. Requirements 5, 7, and 8 will not be covered in class.

ELECTRICITY: Requirement 2

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE:

FIRST AID/HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONS: Counselor prefers this class be taken by Scouts who have reached First Class rank. If not First Class, they should bring their Scout Handbook to verify all first aid requirements for TF, 2C, and 1C have been completed and signed off by leader. Scouts should complete First Aid requirements 5a and 5b, and bring their personal first aid kits to class as if they were prepared to go on a hike of at least three miles.

LEATHERWORK: Requirement 1

MOVIEMAKING: Bring phone or camera in order to record video.

PERSONAL MANAGEMENT: Scouts must be 14 years old and First

Class. Counselor will request reassignment to different class if the scout doesn't meet these requirements.

LEAVE NO TRACE: PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS NOT A MERIT BADGE! This

is a training award that can be earned by both youth and adults that will be offered during the morning session.
